AWARD CATEGORIES



Three finalists will be selected by the panel of judges, and the winners will be announced during the PACE Awards and Gala dinner on 3rd May 2017 at the Hilton Hotel Liverpool.

These prestigious awards are open to all PACE members either by self-nomination or third-party nomination. Winners receive superb trophies. Details of the awards are summarised below.

A: Partnership with Industry Award

This award is looking for examples of activity that promotes a good experience with another organisation. For example a partnership with an employer, where the lecturer goes into industry, or the employer comes into the college.

B: Innovation within a Study Programme

This award is looking for innovative examples of learning and teaching practices within a study programme to engage and inspire students. For example enabling the students to succeed, achieve and expand their skills and knowledge, ensuring they are work and industry ready, to the best of the students' individual abilities. Activities within the study programme should also include the incorporation of Maths and English.

C: Innovative Practices in Creating School Partnerships

This award is looking for examples where colleges/training providers have linked successfully with schools in order to provide a rich and rewarding experience for potential hospitality students from high schools and sixth form colleges. The project should demonstrate a diverse range of realistic activities and excellent progression rates onto hospitality study programmes.

D: Hospitality Team of the Year Award

This award is looking for an outstanding team of educators/trainers/assessors who have worked cooperatively and purposefully with colleagues in order to develop a range of study programmes within Hospitality and Catering which are inspirational and demonstrate high standards and success rates.

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E: Award for Environmental Sustainability

This award is looking for a College Hospitality & Catering Department that has developed the most innovative Sustainability & Environmental Management Project in terms of:

1. Economic benefits
2. Environmental benefits (reducing waste, water, travel, pollution, energy)
3. Social (local sourcing of goods/provenance, product responsibility and consumers, community involvement, basic human rights; fair operating procedures)
4. Innovative staff/student engagement activity to achieve this

Projects might feature some or all of the following categories:

- New build projects
 - Refurbishment of kitchens, restaurants and training/classrooms
 - Provenance/seasonal menus/sustainable procurement
 - Choice of materials/suppliers
 - Low energy/energy efficient equipment
 - Ergonomics/work flow/storage/preparation
 - Transportation/delivery/food miles
 - Recycling/waste management/low environmental impacts
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Lifetime Achievement Award

Awarded to the individual who has contributed significantly to the enhancement of catering education in UK.

- The closing date for entries is 10th March 2017. Any supporting material must also be received by this date. Judging takes place w/c 20 March 2017.
- The judges' decision is final and no correspondence can be entered into.
